Directions to the Musquash

From Rte 93 & 102 - Rt 93 to Exit 4 (rte 102 west);
3.9 miles to a right turn(north) onto High Range Road;
3.1 miles to a left turn onto Hickory Hill Drive

From Mammoth Road - Pillsbury Road west at traffic
light to High Range Road (approx. 1 mile);
right turn onto High Range Road;
1.2 miles to a left turn onto Hickory Hill Drive

From Manchester via Rte 28 & Mammoth Rd - Rte 28
south to Mammoth Road; turn right (west) onto
Litchfield Road at the first traffic light;
.8 mile to a left on Alexander Road;
.6 mile to a left on High Range Rd;
1.1 miles, just beyond the power lines, to a right on Hickory Hill
