Directions to the Musquash

From Rte 93 & 102 – Rte. 93 to Exit 4 (Rte 102) west;
3.9 miles to a right turn (north) onto High Range Road;
3.1 miles to a left turn onto Hickory Hill Drive

From Mammoth Road – Pillsbury Road west at traffic light to High Range Road (approx. 1 mile);
right turn onto High Range Road;
1.2 miles to a left turn onto Hickory Hill Drive

From Manchester via Rte 28 & Mammoth Road – Rte 28 south to Mammoth Road;
Turn right (west) onto Litchfield Road at the first blinking light;
.8 mile to a left turn on Alexander Road;
.6 mile to a left on High Range Road;
1.1 miles, just beyond power lines, to a right on Hickory Hill Drive
