IV. New Business:

- **A.)** Lt. Jason Breen presented the Londonderry police budget 2018-19 fiscal year.
 - Airport coverage reduced due to passenger decrease.
 - Numbers of arrests and incident reports have increased since 2011.
 - Many projects affecting police services in town – includes development and new companies built by airport area.
 - They will continue evaluating impact on police force as town growth continues.
 - Sufficient police coverage currently.
- **B.)** Presentation by Mr. Edwards about Nelson Road softball field lights replacement.
 - Looking at cost of \$130,000.
 - New lights will reduce sky pollution, energy use, maintenance costs by 50%.
 - Old poles are at or close to expected life (40 yrs.)
 - Will improve player safety by less glare in eyes.
 - Small one-time tax increase.
