Londonderry Department announces a new procedure for residents to call in for outside seasonal burning.

Beginning on Thursday January 1, 2015 residents will be able to use the following phone number to call in and check the status of outside burning for the day. Residents who hold a valid 2015 seasonal burning permit issued by the Londonderry Fire Department now need only to call **432-1100 Ext. 311 or 421-1380** and listen to the prerecorded message for the day.

Callers will hear one of the following messages.

- FIRES:** You have reached the Londonderry Fire Department burning permit hotline. If you have a valid seasonal category 1 or 2 burning permit, it is safe to have a camp or cooking fire today. Please follow all outside burning permit guidelines and have a nice day.
- NO FIRES:** You have reached the Londonderry Fire Department burning permit hotline. We are **NOT** allowing burning today due to the fire danger classification issued by the State of NH. Please check back tomorrow for an update. Have a nice day.

Permits are still required to be renewed on an annual basis at the Londonderry Central Fire Station.

If you do not have a valid **2015** burning permit you can obtain one at Londonderry Central Fire Stations located at 280 Mammoth Rd. Londonderry.

If you are **NOT** the property owner you will need **written permission** from the **property owner** with you in order to obtain a permit.

Reminder: If you have **100%** snow cover **100 feet** surrounding your fire site you do not need a permit to burn in Londonderry.
