-We are looking at Auburn Rd, a 12 acre site

-They have done projects in Manchester, NH, Bristol, VT and Hinesburg, VT

-The Town can own or lease the project

-\$800,000 to \$1 million is the estimated cost to bring three phase power to the Auburn Rd site. It is a 1.3 mile distance.

-Community usage is not currently available, only Town and School

-Looking at a 2 mega watt site

-They submitted a conceptual site plan

- Project is only fiscally responsible with the Town/Schools together

2. Presentation by Henry Herndon of CPCNH

-19 Communities Currently Participating

-Hudson has joined this program. They are supportive of the program and are willing to share information with us.

-Not currently operating in NH

-Joining the board would be no financial risk to Londonderry

-The Joint Agreement will be sent to all members and to Mike Malaguti.

- They will make a presentation to the Town Council
