## **Library Services**

<u>Circulating Items</u> – Audio books, books, CD books, large print books, magazines, paperbacks, Playaways, videos, DVDs and music CDs are all available to borrow from the library.

<u>Downloadable Books</u> - We are members of the New Hampshire State Library Downloadable Audios Consortium which allows our patrons to download audiobooks and e-books onto CDs, MP3 players and e-readers.

<u>Reserves</u> - You may reserve a title that is checked out from the Library and we will call you when it is returned.

<u>Renewals</u> - Materials may be renewed online, over the phone, or at the Library if there is not a reserve on them.

<u>Interlibrary Loan</u> - You must have a valid Leach Library card and be a patron in good standing (no overdue books or outstanding fines exceeding \$10.00) in order for us to borrow books from other libraries for you. There are no renewals on interlibrary loan material.

<u>Computer Access</u> – WiFi access is available, as well as internet and word processing services on the public computers.

<u>Programs</u> – The library offers programs for adults on various topics of interest presented by entertainers, educators, and other field experts. There are a variety of programs for children of all ages and young adults throughout the year.

<u>Museum Passes</u> – The library offers a variety of museum passes that can be reserved in advance by calling 432-1132.

<u>Used Book Store</u> - A variety of materials are available at low prices. The book store will be open during its regular hours, Tuesdays from 9:30 - 11:30 a.m. and Thursdays from 6:00 - 7:45 p.m. Donations of good used books, DVDs, music CDs, CD books, games and puzzles will be accepted following the guidelines for donations which are available on this website, at the Circulation Desk or at the Book Store.

<u>Public Meeting Room</u> - We have a versatile meeting room on the lower level which is made available to Londonderry's non-profit organizations. All meetings must be free and open to the public. If you wish to reserve the library's public meeting room, please stop by the library to pick up an application.

<u>Group Study Room</u> – The group study room is available for groups of between 2 and 8 library patrons working together. It may not be reserved in advance.

<u>Quiet Study Room</u> – The quiet study room is available for adults and may not be reserved in advance.

<u>Display Case</u> - It is the policy of the library to provide space for exhibits and displays from the library's own collection and those of other community agencies or individuals. If you wish to reserve the display case, please stop by the library to pick up an application.

<u>Community Bulletin Board</u> – This board is available for non-commercial, non-profit, local organizations that are not promoting religious or political forums. It is subject to space availability and approval of the Library Director.

<u>Photocopy Machines -</u> There are two copiers available for public use at 10 cents per page.
