Call to Order:

Head of Reference and Technical Services' Report:

- On May 24, 2021, the HVAC units were cleaned and prepped for the summer.
- On June 1, 2021, the front door handle would not open from the outside when unlocked. Our locksmith looked at it today and determined it needs to be repaired. Repair time currently is unknown, so we will prop it open during browsing hours.

- Beginning on Monday, June 28, 2021 at 10:00 a.m., Miss Jennifer reads a special bedtime story called "The First Star"! This story time features a book written by Londonderry author Janice Spina and illustrated by her husband John Spina.

Circulation and Children's –

In addition, the library will only track occupancy on an as-needed basis to allow for staff coverage at the Children's Circulation Desk. Seating will remain limited during this phase. The book sale case will be available during browsing hours.
