- Transferred \$2500 to concerts on the common for the band. Will continue having them plan the band for the night
- Seniors were pleased with the bingo prizes

- Was under budget
- Attendance was good
- Movie night at the police station went well
- Derry police and Fire and Londonderry police and fire want to continue next year with an annual softball game. The police department will coordinate.

# Friday Concert and Fireworks

- Everyone liked the new viewing area
- Needed trash barrels around the field
- Could not see the ground fireworks due to the trees. The RFQ should specify no ground fireworks.
- There was some confusion over the fireworks bidding process. The RFQ needs to be sent out in February
- If music is going to be played on the speakers during the fireworks then they should use the bandstand speakers
- The kids games will be moved to the back of the field so that sack races and an obstacle course can be done

#### Saturday

- Coffee and donuts at the Old Home Day Booth from the Resurrection Church were great
- Needed more kids to volunteer to run the carnival games. The cost was \$4200 for the higher end prizes. Kathy will pick some different games since some of the games didn't work well.

- The battle of the chiefs raised over \$200 for the keeping up the common memorial fund
- Booths sold out and raised over \$5000, the prices will remain the same next year
- Bandstand cost was \$3000
- Parade went well with the earlier start time. Having 4 people at the entry to direct people worked well. Parking was better. Budget was \$13,000. Having the 4 local bands was great. The NH Scottish Band was \$1500.
- Baby contest went well with over 30 contestants. We will continue to have the judges being two pageant winners, one senior and one youth
- Bingo saw record numbers. Will have a registration table next year to better control the bingo card distribution.
- Lion's club had to close early because they ran out of food
- Londonderry Sings will not be held next year since there has been declining contestants
- Night time road race went well
- Applestock went well
- Rotary Car show went well
- Day of service went well
- Historical Society went well and had a nice selection of crafters
- Touch a truck went well

#### Finance

- \$9825 was collected in sponsorships
- Beginning fund balance was \$23960, town appropriation was \$10150, Revenue was \$17860 for a total of \$51970. Expenses were \$29346.63. The finance department has the account details.
- John will discuss with the town council making the old home day appropriation part of the town budget

### Administration

- A town resolution was created in 2001 that recognized the old home day committee as a town
  committee and named a town position as being the committee chairperson. That town position
  was eliminated several years later and Kathy Wagner accepted the committee chairperson
  position. The town council will now decide the town employee that will lead the committee.
