### Agenda items discussion:

#### Discussions with Town Staff

- Bob handed out the waste oil collection schedule 2022 for the committee to review. If the schedule does not work for those that man the oil collection site, then it will give them some time to adjust the schedule.
- Lynn asked the Town Manager about approximately \$1,400 in the SWEC budget that was noted to be used for the Town Forest. The Town Manager said that the money should be transferred to the Town's Administration so they will be responsible for it.
- Bob said that, weather permitting, the Drop Off Center will be open the two Saturdays after New Years, (January 8<sup>th</sup> and January 15<sup>th</sup>) from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm for those residents that need to drop off holiday related recyclables.
- Bob spoke about the trash/recycling collection schedule during the holidays and mentioned that there will be no affect on the schedule due to Christmas and New Year's being on Saturdays this year. Normal collection schedule will be in place for both weeks.

#### **Old Business**

- Bob gave a summary report for Household Hazardous Day collection day that
  was held in November. He said that there were approximately 376 vehicles
  that dropped off HHW that day and that HHW was packed into 192
  containers. He also spoke about what items were dropped off.
- Sponsor-A-Road John said that Bosch has reviewed the documents specifying the Town requirements and are ready to move forward. John will get a proof of the typical sign made for committee approval. John said he would like to pursue other businesses to see if he can get other companies to Sponsor a Road in Town.
- Lynn would like to get something out on social media regarding the holiday recycling drop off at the drop off center. Bob will forward to the committee the notices that DPW has created.
- John handed out an example of a sign-up sheet that the committee might hand out to residents to help gather information from the residents about their solid waste ideas that the committee might use.
- John said that Tom Hodge from the Town's IT Department is looking into some social media issues.
- Ron spoke on the possibility of forming a task force in Town to examine the
  use of solar power to offer a net zero option to the Town's power usage. It
  appears Londonderry's Town Council is planning to form a Task Force to
  explore this. Derry has done this, and they are going to construct a Solar
  Facility at the Towns landfill. The committee discussed the possibility of
  putting a solar facility at the Town Landfill on Auburn Road.
- Lynn said that instead of trying to go over all possible committee goals at this
  meeting, he wants the committee to send him a list of goals that the
  committee might work on during 2022. These will be further discussed at the
  Jaunuary committee meeting

- The committee members had a discussion the possibility of moving the Welcome to Londonderry sign from its location at Wendy's to another location along Route 102
- Bob handed out the waste oil collection numbers from 2021.
- Lynn said that he was going to set up a Zoom meeting with an organics collection company to see if that might be something that we can do in Town,
