Agenda items discussion:

- Deb Paul is not running for Town Council so we will have to wait and see who Town Council picks as our new committee liaison.
- The Welcome to Londonderry sponsor sign was hit by a car and was destroyed. A new signpost and signs will be needed.
- Lynn Wiles, reading Bob Kerry's list of items he wanted to talk about relayed four items he said Bob wanted brought up. Those four issues were as follows:
 - \circ The blue bags for Beautify Londonderry (BL) have been ordered.
 - The two rail trail bins will be redeployed in mid-April weather permitting.
 - The Derry HHW event will be held on 5/20/2023 at West Running Brook Middle School. Londonderry residents are welcome.
 - Bob is still working on the cost data associated with opening the Drop Off Center year-round.

New Business

- The committee had a discussion on election of someone for the Vice Chairman position. After further discussion Duane nominated Joy Muller for that position and it was second by Ron Dunn. The committee voted unanimously for Joy. She will be our new Vice Chairman at the next meeting.
- Ryan said that he asked the lunch personnel at the high school about composting the fruits and vegetables. They indicated that they estimate there are about two pounds a day of extra fruit and vegetables that gets thrown away that could be composted.
- The spring Beautify Londonderry event will be held over three weekends, April 22, April 29, and May 5. BL is looking at partnering with Matthew Thornton on fiber recycling.

Committee Discussions on Old Business

- The committee discussed possible goals for 2023. Some of the topics discussed were as follows:
 - Expanding Beautify Londonderry.
 - $\circ\;$ Increase educational opportunities for the community.
 - School cafeteria food composting
 - Getting involved with the Leach Library evening education program

- The committee discussed where they are on their goals for 2022. That included the following:
 - There was no update on the pollinator pathway, or the fiber recycling goals.
 - Ron discussed the HB242 PFAS elimination from food packaging bill. The bill is in the Commerce and Consumer Affairs committee at the legislature for a vote to move it to a floor vote. Senator Carson backs the bill.
 - Bob is still gathering information on costs associated with a year-round drop off center.
