ORDINANCE 2007-09

***AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO AN AMENDMENT TO THE
MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE VI, CHAPTER XIII, AMBULANCE
FEES AND THE COLLECTION THEREOF***

WHEREAS the Town of Londonderry provides Emergency Medical Services through its Fire Department; and

WHEREAS the Town charges a fee for said services, which are critical to offsetting the cost of providing said services, and

WHEREAS the Town has experienced a significant number of delinquent accounts and should consider additional collection measures;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Londonderry that the Title VI, Chapter XIII of the Municipal Code is hereby amended, effective immediately, to authorize the use of credit agency reporting and collection agencies to reduce the number of delinquent ambulance fee invoices.
